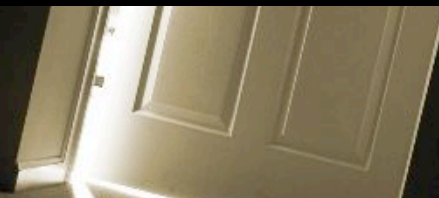

“My children, I will be with you only a little longer. You will look for me, and just as I told the Jews, so I tell you now: Where I am going, you cannot come.”

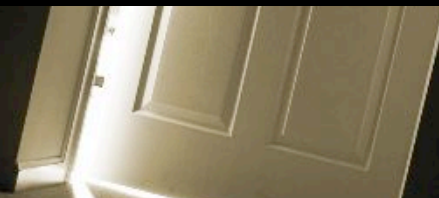

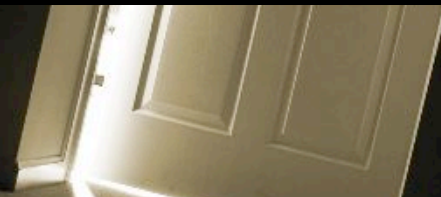
*The way in which Jesus loves is

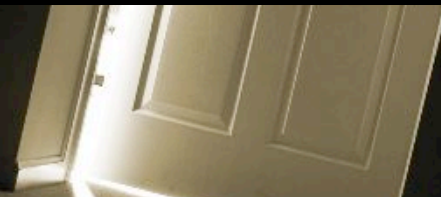


1 John 3:16 (NIV)

* The definitive mark of Christ's disciples is that we love others with selfless sacrifice.

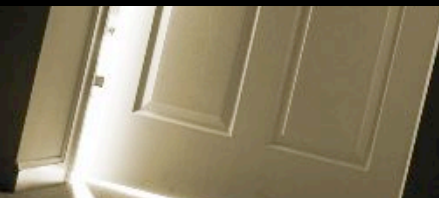

“Simon Peter asked him, ‘Lord, where are you going?’”

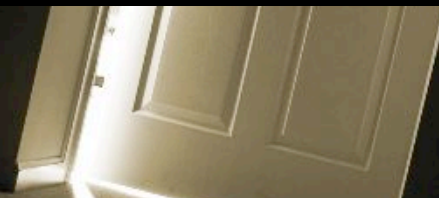

“Where I am going, you cannot follow now, but you will follow later.”

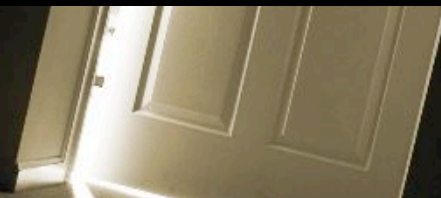

“Then Jesus told them, ‘This very night you will all fall away on account of me, for it is written: I will strike the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock will be scattered.’”

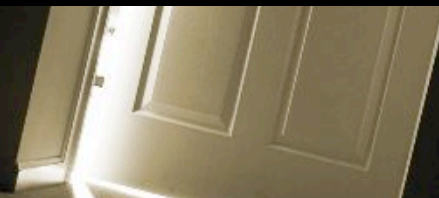

But after I have risen, I will go ahead of you into Galilee.” Peter replied, “Even if all fall away on account of you, I never will.”

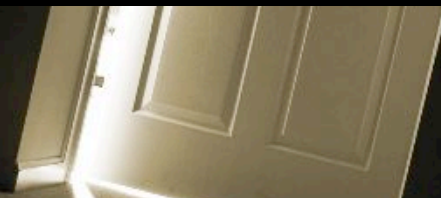

* Your relationship with the Lord can't be based solely on emotions.

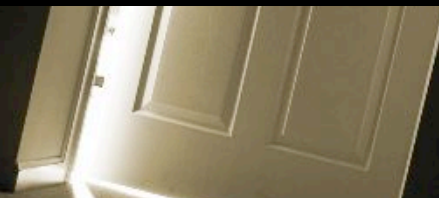

“I tell you the truth...today – yes, tonight – before the rooster crows twice you yourself will disown me three times.’

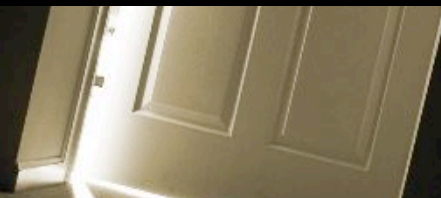

But Peter insisted emphatically, 'Even if I have to die with you, I will never disown you.' And all the others said the same."

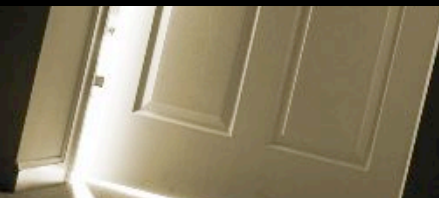

“Simon Peter and another disciple were following Jesus. Because this disciple was known to the high priest, he went with Jesus into the high priest’s courtyard,

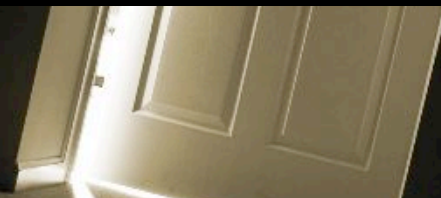

but Peter had to wait outside at the door. The other disciple, who was known to the high priest, came back, spoke to the girl on duty there and brought Peter in.

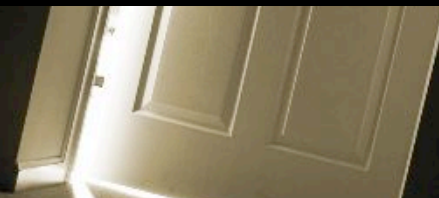

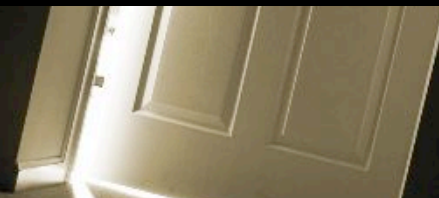

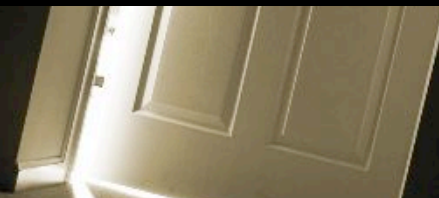

One of the high priest's servants, a relative of the man whose ear Peter had cut off, challenged him, 'Didn't I see you with him in the olive grove?'

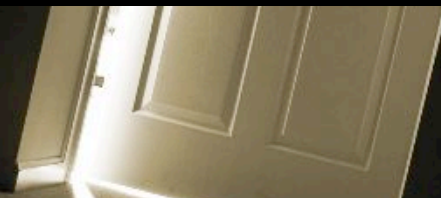

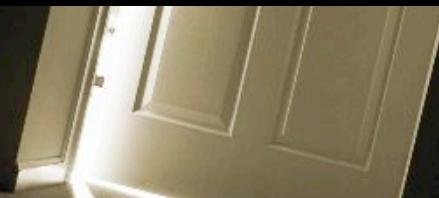

as he told you.”

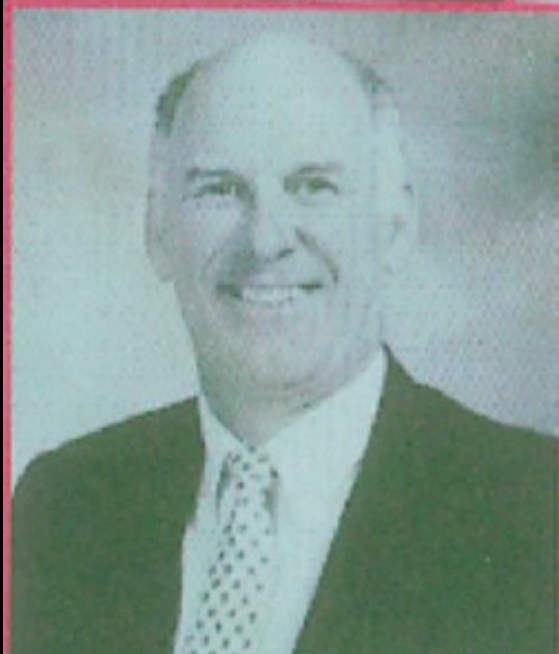

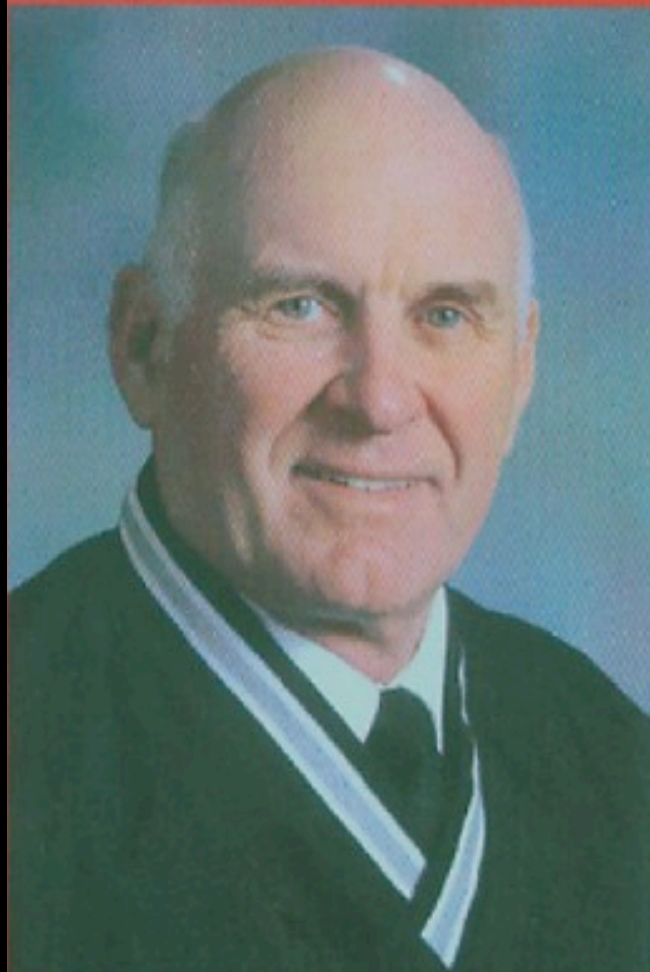
