Some of the clients that HHH serves are homeless. Many of the homeless veterans that the Robert J. Dole VA Medical Center are working with come to HHH for clothing, furniture and appliances for their new residences. The case workers at the VA tell us that they are working more and more with families, whereas in the past most of their homeless clients were single men. Another group of homeless people in the Wichita area also involves families and youth. It is estimated that there are 1,300 youth in the Wichita public school system that do not have a permanent residence. There are many situations involved with this statistic, but it is a sad situation to contemplate.

A local church plant in downtown Wichita, City Life, decided to do something about this by organizing a pillow drive for the clients of HHH. Their goal is to donate 1,300 new pillows to HHH for distribution to HHH clients. Last Sunday we loaded the HHH truck with over 600 pillows! HHH is always needing pillows, blankets, bedding, measuring spoons, measuring cups, forks, spoons and knives.
