Post-Traumatic Stress and Combat Trauma result when reactions to a traumatic or life-threatening event continually recur. Military men and women returning home from combat can feel like a stranger in a strange land—disconnected from family, friends, colleagues, neighbors, and even God. For some, what follows are feelings of depression, guilt, fear, and hopelessness—all symptoms of combat trauma.

The PTSD group will be led by Gina Wendt-Blasing and Bob Funcheon. Gina is a licensed marriage and family therapist with experience in PTSD support. Bob is a master level Social Worker and therapist employed by COM-CARE of Sedgwick Co. Bob's desire to improve the lives of soldiers and their families living a dysfunctional and painful life due to traumatic military experiences is inspired by his son, Army Sgt. Alexander Funcheon, who was killed in Baghdad in 2007.
