


LET'S MAKE A DIFFERENCE

FINDING HOPE AGAIN

A local church called HHH to help with a transient family. After talking to the family about their current crisis. HHH helped them with gas for their vehicle and food and invited them to come to an upcoming clothing distribution. There, an HHH counselor met with the family to provide additional prayer support and encouragement. During this meeting, the HHH counselor was able to find a room for them at a local homeless shelter. The transient family was grateful for the help and re-committed their lives to Jesus Christ!

TRANSFORMED LIVES

A family who did not have any household furnishings was referred to HHH. They were depressed and desperate for hope. When the wife came to HHH to pick up some household furnishings, she gave her life to Christ after talking to one of the HHH counselors. A year later, the woman returned to HHH for some assistance with some clothing.
