**II. Overview & Introduction****A. Our Goal is to Know God**

1. **John 17:3** “This is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.
2. We will always fall short in our pursuit.
  - a. There is no sense in which the finite can see the bounds, define the edges of the infinite. Why? There are no edges. There is no shoreline. This being simply is, and finite perspective does not, can never apprehend him fully.

- a. The names God has given to Himself (Self-Disclosure)

**2. The Attributes of God: Incommunicable and Communicable**

- a. **Described:** When we speak of incommunicable or communicable attributes of God, we mean attributes that are either transmissible or nontransmissible to created beings.
  - i. God’s incommunicable attributes are only true of God. They are Natural to Him, that is true of His essential nature. They cannot be communicated (or transmitted) to created beings. These attributes set Him apart from His Creation.
  - ii. God’s communicable attributes are true of God but can also become true of us. Sometimes these are called God’s Moral Attributes since they deal with His interpersonal, relational nature. These attributes can be expressed in limited degree by created being.

**KEY CONCEPTS REGARDING KNOWING GOD AS HE IS**

- God has disclosed truths about Himself through the names He has used for Himself in the Bible.
- Attributes of God are simply descriptions of the way God is.
- We speak of God’s attributes in either of two categories: Incommunicable or Communicable.
- These Attributes are also known as: His Natural Attributes or His Moral Attributes.
- God’s Incommunicable Attributes cannot be true of created beings.
- God’s Communicable Attributes can be true of created beings.
- God is One. Singular, simple, and indivisible.
- God is not an assembly of His separate attributes.
- God is Personal in Nature

- (1). As a Being, What is His heart, the moral character of this Being?
  - (a). We speak of the heart of the person and when we do that we are describing the character of that person or being

**c. On the Unity of God as Relates to Individual Attributes**

## i. Tozer quotes:

- (1). *“God exists in Himself and of Himself. His being He owes to no one. His substance is indivisible. He has no parts but is single in His unitary being.”*
- (2). *“The harmony of His being is the result not of a perfect balance of parts but of the absence of parts.”*
- (3). *“All of God does all that God does; He does not divide himself to perform a work, but works in the total unity of His being.”* Why must this be true?

**d. We are wholly dependent upon the aid of His Spirit** to teach us and impact us with these truths about God.

- i. **1 Corinthians 2:9-13** but just as it is written, “THINGS WHICH EYE HAS NOT SEEN AND EAR HAS NOT HEARD, AND WHICH HAVE NOT ENTERED THE HEART OF MAN, ALL THAT GOD HAS PREPARED FOR THOSE WHO LOVE HIM.”

10 For to us God revealed them through the Spirit; for the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God. 11 For who among men knows the thoughts of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so the thoughts of God no one knows except the Spirit of God.

12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may know the things freely given to us by God, 13 which things we also speak, not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit, combining spiritual thoughts with spiritual words.

**III. The Personhood of God****A. God is Personal in Nature****1. The Personhood of God**

- a. Scripture Relates God as Person-al in Nature as opposed to an Impersonal Force or Power.
- b. *“God is personal. He is an individual being, with self-consciousness and will, capable of feeling, choosing, and having a reciprocal relationship with other personal and social beings. He is not an abstract, unknowable being or a nameless force, he is not an undefined “higher power.” - David Hocking*

**c. Scripture Reveals God as having...**

- i. Mind / Thoughts / Intellect

**d. God is not an “energy” or some vague “cosmic power” that pervades all things.**

- i. All energy and power have their origin from YHWH but do not define Him.

**B. Humanity is Created as Persons, in the Image of God.****1. A Concise Starting Point for Us - We are to Reflect His Image**

- a. **Genesis 1:27** God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

**2. You Shall Be Because I AM**

- a. **Leviticus 11:45** ‘For I am YHWH who brought you up from the land of Egypt to be your God; thus you shall be holy, for I am holy.’”
- b. **1Peter 1:16** because it is written, “YOU SHALL BE HOLY, FOR I AM HOLY.”

**IV. The Moral Attributes of God - True of God by His Interpersonal Nature, Character, Being****A. These Attributes are Communicable to Created Beings and can be exhibited by them.****B. Faithfulness**

1. **Description:** God will never fail to act in a way which is true to His character and to all expressions of His character, including His promised but yet unfulfilled expressions. Faithfulness is Immutability of Integrity.
2. *“God being who He is, cannot cease to be what He is, and being what He is, He cannot act out of character with Himself. He is at once faithful and immutable, so all His words and acts must be and remain faithful.”* – A.W. Tozer
3. **Genesis 21:1** Then the LORD took note of Sarah as He had said, and the LORD did for Sarah as He had promised.
4. **Deuteronomy 7:9** “Know therefore that the LORD your God, He is God, the faithful God, who keeps His covenant and His lovingkindness to a thousandth generation with those who love Him and keep His commandments;
5. **1Kings 8:56** “Blessed be the LORD, who has given rest to His people Israel, according to all that He promised; not one word has failed of all His good promise, which He promised through Moses His servant.

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6. **Nehemiah 1:5** I said, "I beseech You, O LORD God of heaven, the great and awesome God, who preserves the covenant and lovingkindness for those who love Him and keep His commandments,
7. **Psalms 36:5** Your lovingkindness, O LORD, extends to the heavens, Your faithfulness reaches to the skies.
8. **Psalms 143:1** Hear my prayer, O LORD, Give ear to my supplications! Answer me in Your faithfulness, in Your righteousness!
9. **Isaiah 25:1** O LORD, You are my God; I will exalt You, I will give thanks to Your name; For You have worked wonders, Plans formed long ago, with perfect faithfulness.
10. **1Corinthians 1:9** God is faithful, through whom you were called into fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.
11. **1Thessalonians 5:24** Faithful is He who calls you, and He also will bring it to pass.
12. **2Timothy 2:13** If we are faithless, He remains faithful, for He cannot deny Himself.
13. **1Peter 4:19** Therefore, those also who suffer according to the will of God shall entrust their souls to a faithful Creator in doing what is right.
14. **1John 1:9** If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

**C. Justice**

1. **Description:** Justice is the outworking of the righteous nature of God in the realm of moral creatures. The limitless framework of His moral character. Justice embodies the idea of moral equity.
2. *"In the inspired Scriptures justice and righteousness are scarcely to be distinguished from each other."* – A.W. Tozer
3. *"Justice, when used of God, is a name we give to the way God is, nothing more; and when God acts justly He is not doing so to conform to an independent criterion, but simply acting like Himself in a given situation."* – A.W. Tozer
4. *"Sin is the dare of God's justice, the rape of His mercy, the jeer of His patience, the slight of His power, and the contempt of His love."* – John Bunyan
5. **Genesis 18:25** "Far be it from You to do such a thing, to slay the righteous with the wicked, so that the righteous and the wicked are treated alike. Far be it from You! Shall not the Judge of all the earth deal justly?"
6. **Exodus 34:6-7** Then YHWH passed by in front of him and proclaimed, "YHWH, YHWH God, compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in lovingkindness and truth; 7 who keeps lovingkindness for thousands, who forgives iniquity, transgression and sin; yet He will by no means leave the guilty unpunished, visiting the iniquity of fathers on the children and on the grandchildren to the third and fourth generations."

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7. **Deuteronomy 32:3-4** “For I proclaim the name of YHWH; Ascribe greatness to our God! 4 “The Rock! His work is perfect, For all His ways are just; A God of faithfulness and without injustice, Righteous and upright is He.
8. **Job 34:12** “Surely, God will not act wickedly, And the Almighty will not pervert justice.
9. **Psalms 89:14** Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; Lovingkindness and truth go before You.
10. **Acts 17:31** because He has fixed a day in which He will judge the world in righteousness through a Man whom He has appointed, having furnished proof to all men by raising Him from the dead.”
11. **1John 1:9** If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
12. **Revelation 16:7** And I heard the altar saying, “Yes, O Lord God, the Almighty, true and righteous are Your judgments.”

**D. Wrath**

1. **Description:** The personal manifestation of God’s holy, moral character in judgment against sin. Wrath is neither an impersonal process nor irrational and fitful like anger. It is in no way vindictive or malicious. It is holy indignation — God’s anger directed against sin.
2. *“The holiness of God, the wrath of God, and the health of the creation are inseparably united. God’s wrath is His utter intolerance of whatever degrades and destroys. He hates iniquity as a mother hates the polio that take the life of her child.”* – A.W. Tozer
3. *“It is partly because sin does not provoke our own wrath, that we do not believe that sin provokes the wrath of God.”* – R. W. Dale
4. *“The fact is that the subject of divine wrath has become taboo in modern society, and Christians by and large have accepted the taboo and conditioned themselves never to raise the matter.”* – J.I. Packer
5. **Deuteronomy 32:35** ‘Vengeance is Mine, and retribution, In due time their foot will slip; For the day of their calamity is near, And the impending things are hastening upon them.’
6. **John 3:36** “He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him.”
7. **Romans 2:5-8** But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God, :6 who WILL RENDER TO EACH PERSON ACCORDING TO HIS DEEDS: 7 to those who by perseverance in doing good seek for glory and honor and immortality, eternal life; 8 but to those who are selfishly ambitious and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, wrath and indignation.
8. **Romans 9:22** What if God, although willing to demonstrate His wrath and to make His power known, endured with much patience vessels of wrath prepared for destruction?

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9. **Ephesians 2:1-3** And you were dead in your trespasses and sins, 2 in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience. 3 Among them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest.
10. **Revelation 19:15** From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty.

**E. Mercy**

1. **Description:** Mercy is the ready inclination of God to relieve the misery of fallen creatures, the goodness of God confronting human suffering and also guilt. Mercy is expressed by God when that which is deserved by His creatures is withheld, to the benefit of the object of the mercy.
2. *Grace is when God gives us what we don't deserve. Mercy is when God doesn't give us what we do deserve.* – Unknown
3. *"To receive mercy we must first know that God is merciful. And it is not enough to believe that He once showed mercy to Noah or Abraham or David and will again show mercy in some happy future day. We must believe that God's mercy is boundless, free and, through Jesus Christ our Lord, available to us now in our present situation."* – A.W. Tozer
4. **Exodus 33:19** And he said, I will make all my goodness pass before thee, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before thee; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy.
5. **Exodus 34:6-7** And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, 7 Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation.
6. **Numbers 14:18** The LORD is longsuffering, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation.
7. **1Chronicles 16:34** O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever.
8. **Psalms 103:17** But the mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children;
9. **Psalms 136:1** O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever. (repeated throughout chapter 136)
10. **Psalms 145:8-9** The LORD is gracious and merciful; Slow to anger and great in lovingkindness. 9 The LORD is good to all, And His mercies are over all His works.

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11. **Lamentations 3:22-23** It is of the LORD's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. 23 They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.
12. **Ephesians 2:4-7** But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, 5 even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ ( by grace you have been saved), 6 and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, 7 so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.
13. **Titus 3:5** He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit,
14. **Hebrews 4:16** Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
15. **1Peter 1:3** Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,
16. **1Peter 2:9-10** But you are A CHOSEN RACE, A royal PRIESTHOOD, A HOLY NATION, A PEOPLE FOR God's OWN POSSESSION, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; 10 for you once were NOT A PEOPLE, but now you are THE PEOPLE OF GOD; you had NOT RECEIVED MERCY, but now you have RECEIVED MERCY.

## F Grace

1. **Description:** The good pleasure of God that inclines Him to bestow benefits upon the undeserving. When we speak of God's grace, we speak of those wonderful gifts (including salvation) that no man deserves but God grants by His Gracious intent.
2. *"They will never accept grace until they tremble before a just and holy law."* – C.H. Spurgeon
3. *"The ultimate test of our spirituality is the measure of our amazement at the grace of God."*  
– Martyn Lloyd-Jones
4. *"Just as the sinner's despair of any hope from himself is the first prerequisite of a sound conversion, so the loss of all confidence in himself is the first essential in the believer's growth in grace."*  
– A. W. Pink
5. **Genesis 39:4** And Joseph found grace in his sight, and he served him: and he made him overseer over his house, and all that he had he put into his hand.
6. **Exodus 33:19** And He said, "I Myself will make all My goodness pass before you, and will proclaim the name of the LORD before you; and I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show compassion on whom I will show compassion."
7. **John 1:16-17** For of His fullness we have all received, and grace upon grace. 17 For the Law was given through Moses; grace and truth were realized through Jesus Christ.
8. **Romans 3:24** being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;

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9. **Romans 5:15-20** But the free gift is not like the transgression. For if by the transgression of the one the many died, much more did the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abound to the many. 16 The gift is not like that which came through the one who sinned; for on the one hand the judgment arose from one transgression resulting in condemnation, but on the other hand the free gift arose from many transgressions resulting in justification. 17 For if by the transgression of the one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ. 18 So then as through one transgression there resulted condemnation to all men, even so through one act of righteousness there resulted justification of life to all men. 19 For as through the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, even so through the obedience of the One the many will be made righteous. 20 The Law came in so that the transgression would increase; but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more,
10. **Romans 11:5-6** In the same way then, there has also come to be at the present time a remnant according to God's gracious choice. 6 But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works, otherwise grace is no longer grace.
11. **Ephesians 1:3-8** Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, 4 just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. In love 5 He predestined us to adoption as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will, 6 to the praise of the glory of His grace, which He freely bestowed on us in the Beloved. 7 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace 8 which He lavished on us.
12. **Ephesians 2:4-9** But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, 5 even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ ( by grace you have been saved), 6 and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, 7 so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. 8 For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; 9 not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.
13. **Hebrews 4:16** Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
14. **Titus 2:11** For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men,

**G. Love**

1. **Description:** The love of God is the character trait of God whereby He expresses His beneficent goodness to His creatures.
2. *"God's unfailing love for us is an objective fact affirmed over and over in the Scriptures. It is true whether we believe it or not. Our doubts do not destroy God's love, nor does our faith create it. It originates in the very nature of God, who is love, and it flows to us through our union with His beloved Son."* – Jerry Bridges

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3. *“God’s love is an exercise of His goodness towards individual sinners whereby, having identified Himself with their welfare, He has given His Son to be their Saviour, and now brings them to know and enjoy Him in a covenant relation.”* – J.I. Packer
4. *“Do you wish to see God’s love? Look at the Cross. Do you wish to see God’s wrath? Look at the Cross.”* – D.A. Carson
5. **Deuteronomy 7:9** Know therefore that YAHWEH your God is God; he is the faithful God, keeping his covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love him and keep his commands.
6. **Psalms 37:28** For YAHWEH loves the just and will not forsake his faithful ones. They will be protected forever, but the offspring of the wicked will be cut off;
7. **Psalms 103:8** YAHWEH is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love.
8. **Psalms 103:17** But the loyal love of YAHWEH is from everlasting to everlasting on those who fear him, and his righteousness to their children’s children,
9. **Romans 5:1-9** Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, 2 through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God. 3 And not only this, but we also exult in our tribulations, knowing that tribulation brings about perseverance; 4 and perseverance, proven character; and proven character, hope; 5 and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us. 6 For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. 7 For one will hardly die for a righteous man; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die. 8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. 9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him.
10. **Romans 8:35-39** Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? 36 As it is written: “For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered.” 37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. 38 For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, 39 neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
11. **John 3:16** For in this way God loved the world, so that he gave his one and only Son, in order that everyone who believes in him will not perish, but will have eternal life.
12. **Romans 5:8** But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
13. **Galatians 2:20** I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
14. **Ephesians 2:4-5** But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, 5 made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved.

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15. **Titus 3:4-7** But when the kindness of God our Savior and His love for mankind appeared, :5 He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, 6 whom He poured out upon us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, 7 so that being justified by His grace we would be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.
16. **1John 3:16** This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers.
17. **1John 4:8-9** Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love. 9 This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. 10 This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. 11 Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.
