

## Finding *hope* again

A church in Wichita called HHH to help with a transient family. After talking to the family about their current crisis, HHH helped them with food for meals, gas for their vehicle, and invited them to attend a clothing distribution. During the distribution, an HHH counselor met with the family to provide additional prayer support and encouragement. Through local connections, the counselor was able to find a room for them at a homeless shelter. The family was grateful and recommitted their lives to Jesus Christ!

## *Changing hearts*

A family desperate for help and without household furnishings was referred to HHH. When the mother came to pick up the items, she gave her life to Christ after talking to one of the HHH counselors. A year later, the woman returned to HHH for assistance with clothing where she told the counselor she'd committed her life to Christ during her previous HHH visit and that her life had been turned around after this commitment. All five family members are now saved and at a local church experiencing God's blessings daily.
