Job Title: Head Cook

Reports to: Food Service Director

Central Christian Academy seeks an outstanding person to serve as the head cook for its food service program. The ideal candidate will have a vibrant Christian faith and experience in food service.

Description

The Head Cook Position reports to the Food Service Director and will lead the preparation of food for the school's K-12 lunch program. This position requires a minimum of 25 hours per week from August to May with the potential of increasing up to 40 hours per week.

Spiritual Requirements

- Evidence of a committed and mature faith in Jesus Christ
- A belief that the Bible is God's inerrant and infallible Word
- Evidence of active church attendance and membership at a church whose statement of faith is consistent with that of CCC and CCA
- Agreement with CCA's Mission, Core Values, Purpose, Statement of Faith, Biblical Lifestyle Statement, and Statement on Life, Marriage, Gender Identify and Human Sexuality
- Willingness to serve as a Christian role model as outlined in the CCA employee handbook
- Willingness to set an example of prayer, Bible study and unity in Christian fellowship
- Commitment to resolve professional and personal conflict biblically
- Models servant leadership and has the ability to build relationships and support CCA's mission
- Listens and responds to counsel

Duties and Professional Requirements

- Collaborate with the Kitchen Manager and other kitchen staff to create menus and order food for the lunch program in a timely and consistent manner
- Provide leadership and direction for other staff in the preparation of the menu items
- Oversee proper functioning of kitchen food preparation equipment, including monitoring equipment temperatures
- Responsible to review weekly menu and pull frozen foods to thaw
- Prepare and cook food for daily meals

- Assist with serving meals to students
- Work with other staff to keep the kitchen and equipment clean and organized
- Work with the kitchen manager to purchase proper inventory of ingredients and food items in a timely manner
- Provide leadership to other staff in the handling of food, temperature control, serving protocols, and proper storage of food items
- Ability to engage with students and teachers
- Strong communication skills in both speech and writing
- Recognition of the need for good public relations
- Ability to represent the school in a professional manner to its constituency and the general public
- Commitment to professional confidentiality with all information regarding all staff and students

Experience

- Experience working in food service, restaurant, or school lunch program strongly preferred
- Experience working with school-aged children preferred
- Food handler certification required

Physical Requirements:

- The ability to stand, walk, sit, kneel, bend, reach, grip, climb, push, pull, or carry, for a duration of time
- Ability to lift and carry 40 pounds
- The ability to use fine motor skills including tactile functions while performing a task
- The ability to work in a kitchen environment which could include hot, cold, dry, moist, and slippery environments. Other environmental factors could be surface noise, lighting, vibrations, and smell.
